This funding will be used to


- Continue the development of the Wik Mungkan language program to build on the knowledge base of our local community staff members, develop and resource learning programs.
- Build on the work started in semester 2, 2019 to introduce our school values, strengthen Positive Behaviour for learning (PBL) across the school, build staff capacity in classroom management as we work towards creating a culture that promotes learning.

Our initiatives include

- Developing and publishing resources for use in lessons in partnership with local community experts.
- Collaboratively developing unit plans with our language team, a Linguist, Head of Curriculum and community experts. By the end of 2020 all primary students will be engaged in weekly language lessons.
- Providing opportunities for our language team to learn about the operation of similar successful programs in schools. Our language team will be upskilled to deliver a program comparable to other successful language programs.
- Providing opportunities for our Non local staff and community members to engage in learning opportunities with Wik Mungkan.
- Provide training opportunities for teaching staff in Classroom Profiling and introduce regular opportunities to profile and be profiled. Twice yearly a school wide profiling sweep will be completed with an increase in teachers ability to manage universal classroom behaviours.
- Provide training opportunities for all staff in Positive Behaviour for Learning and Zones of Regulation.
- Provide coaching to all teachers around successful classroom management and engagement.
- Developing proactive programs for identified Tier 2 and Tier 3 students such as the Wellbeing Room and Art Therapy.
- Strengthen the work started on the Aurukun State School values and develop explicit behavior lessons based on our PBL matrix taught weekly in all classrooms.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Employing a Linguist to support planning of units and resource development | \$ 60,000 |
| • Resourcing the Wik Mungkan Language program and providing PD opportunities | \$ 40,000 |
| • Employ a HoD – Student Wellbeing and Classroom Management to coach teachers and lead improvement work around PBL, student wellbeing programs and fully implement the values. | \$119,000 |
| • Resourcing Student Wellbeing room and wellbeing programs | \$ 36,511 |
